Juliet Compston is Professor of Bone Medicine and Honorary Consultant Physician at the University of Cambridge School of Clinical Medicine. She is a past President of the Bone and Tooth Society of Great Britain and Chairman and Vice-President of the International Society of Bone Morphometry. She is a member of the Board of the International Osteoporosis Foundation, a Trustee of the Board of Management of the National Osteoporosis Society and a member of Council of the European Calcified Tissues Society. She is also a member of the Board of the International Bone and Mineral Society.

Professor Compston was co-author of the 1998 Report on Osteoporosis in the European Community and is Project Leader of the Call to Osteoporosis Action, a project funded by the European Union to ensure implementation of the recommendations of the EC Report. She also represents the IOF on the Bone and Joint Health Strategies Project. Professor Compston combines clinical and research work and has a particular interest in the mechanisms by which bone active drugs affect the skeleton. She also has an interest in clinical guidelines and has chaired the working groups for the Royal College of Physicians/Bone and Tooth Society Update on the Prevention and Treatment of Osteoporosis and for the Bone and Tooth Society/National Osteoporosis Society and Royal College of Physicians Guidelines on the Management of Glucocorticoid-induced Osteoporosis.
